

Policy: Outstanding Service Award

Purpose:

To recognize and celebrate those members or farms that have had a significant impact on the North Central Highland Cattle Association by dedicating time and effort to support and promote the NCHCA mission.

Eligibility/Selection Criteria:

- Can be awarded to an individual or group of current or former NCHCA members in good standing
- Honoree has made contributions to the NCHCA that had an impact, including such things as:
 - Served in leadership roles on the board or committees
 - Active participation on committee(s)
 - Volunteered time, hosted events, organized activities, etc.
 - Promoted and implemented new initiatives
- Long term involvement is important but not required. Significant effort in a single endeavor is valid for recognition
- While this is not a lifetime achievement award, it is important to recognize members who have had an impact on NCHCA

Selection Process:

- The Board annually determines the number of awards to make in that year
- Board members nominate potential recipients at the January board meeting
- Recipients are decided by consensus of the Board

Award:

- Outstanding Service Award Plaque
- Recognition at the Annual Meeting
 - If possible, officer or board member with some connection to the honoree presents award, or another member with close connection could be asked to speak instead.
- Recognition with photo (if possible) in Hoofbeat and on website
